**Urbanisation Works** 



#### The Project

Moorabool Shire Council's 2017/18 Capital Improvement Program includes the urbanisation of Dicker Street, Gordon adjacent the Gordon Primary School.

The upgrade works incorporate a range of infrastructure and landscaping improvements including;

- · Concrete footpath on the north side
- Parallel and 90° on-street parking, yielding 54 parking spaces
- Kerb & Channel
- New sealed pavement construction & intersection improvements
- New signage & linemarking
- Tree planting

These upgrade works will improve accessibility, connectivity and most importantly safety for all associated with the Primary School Community including students, parents, staff and neighbouring residents.


#### **Timeframe**

Construction works are anticipated to commence on site in late 2017, with an anticipated 12 week construction period. Specific start dates will be communicated to the school administration prior to works commencing.

It is anticipated Dicker Street will be closed for the duration of the construction works, with access to local residents only.

The designated temporary school pickup/drop-off during this period will be via the gate on Hopwood Street as shown below.


